

Billeting Information for Hosting Students

KISSM will be contacting you before camp to make the necessary arrangements regarding payment of billeting fees, etc. This is the time to discuss any concerns or ask any questions to make the hosting experience run smoothly. Attached is the code of conduct for billeting students, for your convenience.

Code of Conduct for Billeting Students

Be polite, helpful, tidy, and respectful.

- Follow the KISSM Rules and Regulations as outlined in your Student Handbook
- If you plan to be absent from the host home for any reason, ensure that you have cleared your intended activity with your host parent and give him/her an estimated time of return. Any overnight stays away from the host home must be arranged between the billeting parent and the host parent in advance.
- Inform your host family well ahead of time of what evening recreation activities you wish to participate in, and when you are to perform at an evening concert so that they can arrange transportation.
- Understand that if you are involved in any illegal activity, including the use of drugs, alcohol, or smoking, you will be sent home immediately (at your expense).
- Be sure to write a letter thanking your host family once you have returned home.
